Torino walking Tour

Starting from Piazza Castello (**Palazzo Madama, Royal Palace, Church of San Lorenzo**) we will visit the Duomo of San Giovanni, where is held the **Holy Shroud**, and continue our walk to reach **Palazzo Carignano**, that leads one of the most elegant corner of the city with its wavy façade. We will end our tour at **Galleria Subalpina** to tell the story of **Bicerin**, the famous Piedmontese hot drink.

Musei Reali (Royal Palace, Royal Armory, Chapel of the holy Shroud)

Palazzo Reale, residence of the House of Savoy until 1865, is ready to welcome you in all its majesty. Along the way you can visit the royal apartments with the throne room, the eighteenth-century boudoirs and the spaces dedicated to dancing. The atmosphere you breathe is that of the baroque court families. You will go from the royal apartments to **the Armory**, where the weapons and armor collected by Carlo Alberto and kept in the Beaumont Gallery, are on display. Along the way also the **Chapel of the Shroud**, reopened in September 2018, after a long restoration.

Meeting point: Piazza Castello, in front of the gate of Palazzo Reale

Duration: 1h 30'



National Museum of Cinema

The exhibition (by the international scenographer **Francois Confino**), runs along the 167 meters of the **Mole Antonelliana**.

The museum is divided into levels, not by rooms. From the “**archeology**” of the **Cinema** (where are exhibited magic lanterns, optical chambers and several inventions and devices that led to the creation of the Cinema) we will continue our tour to the **Cinema Machine** (to understand the production processes and the importance of the public audience) up to the **Temple Hall** (where the 10 “chappelles” will show the various film genres).
